W.A.R. PRAYING FOR CRUSADES

TEN-DAY COMMITMENT (9/13/10 – 9/22/10)

In a united effort, the South Texas District Network of Prayer is launching the *W.A.R. Praying for Crusades* agenda in a ten-day commitment of prayer and fasting on September 13 – September 22, 2010, weeks before the crusades, as spiritual support in preparation for the harvest that God desires to give at the *2010 U.P.C.I. General Conference*. Following is a consolidated prayer guide generated as groundwork in helping to reap the ultimate harvest. Before the actual rendering of corporate prayer and fasting in September, **EVERYONE is requested to begin NOW in prayer** to consistently pray for the targeted areas outlined below. Lift up these prayer focuses before the Lord in prayer throughout the year, in church prayer meetings, at special prayer events, during your personal prayer time, on occasions including prayer, and whenever you have an opportunity to do so (Note: This prayer guide may always be used in application to any major event that you desire to solicit prayer coverage for, in general). Also, later this year all churches will be encouraged to take advantage of the tremendous opportunity in September by participating in the powerful ten-day commitment of corporate fasting (chosen fast: Partial Fast, Rotation Fast, Daniel Fast, John Wesley Fast, or Normal Fast), and corporate prayer by praying for the same specific areas outlined in the prayer guide (Expanded, *W.A.R. Crusade Prayer Guide*). Detailed instructional online literature for the fasting and prayer will be distributed by each Sectional Prayer Coordinator prior to September. Every church is urged to be a part of this purposeful commitment that will support an explosive outreach that will manifest in a great end-time harvest!

SPIRITUAL PREPARATION FOR BATTLE

It is important that you prepare yourself for the battle. Before prayer can be made for another, your heart and mind must be clean, clear, and ready to receive from the Lord. Repent, and then gird up the loins of your mind. Begin with the Lord's Prayer in Matt. 6:9-13. Now, get dressed spiritually. Ephes. 6:10-18 informs us what to wear and who we are fighting. We are to put on the whole armor of God, so we can stand against the wiles/plans of the devil. God is the “*Lord of Host, Mighty in Battle!*” He also is the *Lord of the Harvest!*

PRAY FOR:

PROTECTION

Psalm 34:7 “*The angel of the Lord encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.*”

PROTECTION... through angels (Ps. 35:5-6) ...In traveling to the conference/crusades (Jos. 1:8-9) ...against illnesses (I Pet. 2:24) ...over crusade equipment ...over all crusade attendees (Ps. 125:2) ...over crusade workers (Prov. 18:10) ...over the minds of the laborers (Ephes. 6:17) ...over preached/spoken words to be properly interpreted by the hearers (Isa. 50:5) ...against attacks anywhere (II Sam. 22:3) ...over families and circumstances (Deut. 33:12) ...against all efforts to divert our focus from God's harvest (Ps. 140:7).

GREAT POWER

Acts 4:33 “*And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.*”

GREAT POWER...over contrary powers (Ps. 59:11) ...to tread over ALL the power of the enemy (Luke 10:19) ...over weaknesses of the flesh (Ephes. 3:20) ...over temptations (Matt. 6:13) ...over loneliness (Col. 1:11) ... over fear (II Tim. 1:7) ...over sicknesses and diseases (Mark 16:18)... over Satan's strategies (Mark 16:17) ... over fatigue (Ps. 68:35) ... upon crusade speakers and workers (Acts 4:31) ... to be a witness (Acts 1:8).

AUTHORITY

Luke 9:1 “*Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.*”

AUTHORITY... over spiritual darkness (Ephes. 6:12) ...over anti-God spirits (Matt. 18:18) ...over onsite, local, city, and statewide demonic forces (Matt. 18:19)... over Satan's tactics (II Cor. 2:11) ... over fleshly desires (Ps. 51:10) ... over casualness and weak minds, (Heb. 12:3, Phil. 4:8) ... over disunity (I Pet. 3:8) ... over self (Gal. 5:16).

HARVEST

Matthew 9:38 *“Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest that he will send forth laborers into His harvest.”*

HARVEST... to be promoted and prepared for (John 4:36-37) ...to be compelled by the drawing of God's Spirit (John 12:32) ...to be brought to the crusade by the laborers (Luke 14:23)... to respond to the Word of God gone forth, and to be effectively reaped (II Thes. 3:1, John 4:35) ... to receive great support from trained and empowered altar workers (Job 33:16-17, Ps. 32:8) ...to be IMPACTED by the Spirit of God through crusade workers, and others ... to be expectant of by the Church and later, retained and established (Mark 11:24).

FAVOR

Luke 2:52 *“And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.”*

FAVOR...in the eyes of God, the city, the state, governmental officials, visitors, other religions, unsaved family members, conference authorities, the media, and all others. (Ps. 5:12, Ex. 3:21, Est. 2:15, Luke 1:52, Acts 2:47, I Sam. 5:4, Gen. 39:4, Ps. 119:58, Dan. 1:9, Ps. 5:12) ...for all business dealings and conference and crusade matters (Ex. 12:36, I Sam. 2:26).

UNITY

Ephesians 4:3-6 *“Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.”*

UNITY...with one mind (thoughts, concepts, and imaginations) I Pet. 1:8, 3:8 ...with one accord (purpose, motives, desires) Acts 1:14 ...with one goal (focus, projection, souls) Acts 2:44 ...with one bond of the Spirit (spiritual bonding) John 17:21, Phil. 1:27 ...with one calling (one voice/people) Ps. 133:1 ...with one flow (that everyone moves in the same flow of the Spirit) John 17:22 ... with one Body (that every part would supply to this one Body) John 17:23 ...with the same SPIRIT (make us one) Ephes. 4:4-6 ... among the Churches in the District/U.P.C.I. (Phil. 2:5, 7, Mark 3:24) ...in music (Lam. 3:63) ... in singing (Zeph. 3:17) ...in the messages (Ephes. 4:13, I Cor. 1:10).

FAITH

2Cor. 5:7 *“For we walk by faith and not by sight.”(Our faith is not in us, not even in our prayers, but in the One who hears our prayers.)*

FAITH...to be transmitted during the messages (Rom. 10:17, I Cor. 2:4) ...that is unwavering through the knowledge of the Word of God (Rom. 10:8) ... for miracles, signs and wonders (Mark 11:22) ... to consume us beyond our imagination (Mark 11:24, Heb. 11:1), ... in Christ (Heb. 11:6) ...in the leadership and fellow-saints (Gal. 5:6) ... for moving obstacles (Matt. 17:20) ... to be transmitted, and also for the people to receive miracles (Acts 6:8, Acts 15:9, Matt. 19:29-30) ... for every victory (Luke 18:27, I Cor. 15:57) ... for a great outpouring of the Holy Ghost (Another PENTECOST WITH OVER 3,000 PEOPLE RECEIVING THE HOLY CHOST!) Acts 2:17.

PROMISES

Luke 24:49 *“And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you...”*

PROMISES... to be received so that all flesh would acknowledge God's power (Phil. 2:10) ... to be experienced so that all speak with tongues as the Spirit gives the utterance (Mark 16:17, Acts 2:4, 5:14) ... for the hungry and thirsty to be filled (Matt. 5:6) ... to be given so that every individual be endued with power from on high (Luke 24:49) ... to be released so that all the people be consumed with the FIRE of the Holy Ghost (Matt. 3:11, Acts 2:39) ... to be granted of miracles, signs, wonders, and healings (Mark 16:20, Acts 4:29-31, 5:12, 16) ... to be activated so that every person take this outpouring, in the Spirit, into their cities and countries (Acts 1:8).

WISDOM

Psalms 111:10 *“The fear of the lord is the beginning of wisdom...”*

WISDOM... in the midst of all crusade operations (James 1:5) ...beyond ability in directing crusade team members and directing people to receive the Holy Ghost (Eccles. 2:26) ...in delivering each message (Ps. 51:6) ...in accessing the harvest (Isa. 2:3) ... above intruding opposing spirits (Rom. 8:31) ... over all divisive attempts against all conference/crusade efforts (Prov. 28:5).

WEATHER

Matthew 8:26 *“And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.”*

WEATHER... that is conducive for good crusade/conference attendance (God's weather schedule). Pray against all...types of heat waves, storms, lightning strikes, flooding, hurricanes, hail storms, torrential rains (Amos 4:7)...and all erratic weather conditions. Pray against all drastic changes in weather that would negatively effect God's people and visitors physically, mentally, and spiritually.

Addendum: JOY. (Pray for the aftermath of the crusades that after returning, everyone, especially laborers who may be exhausted, would have total JOY and replenishment) **Luke 24:52** *“And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy.”* Pray that our joy may be FULL (*“These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.”* John 15:11; *“They that sow in tears shall reap in joy. He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.”* Ps. 126:5-6.)
